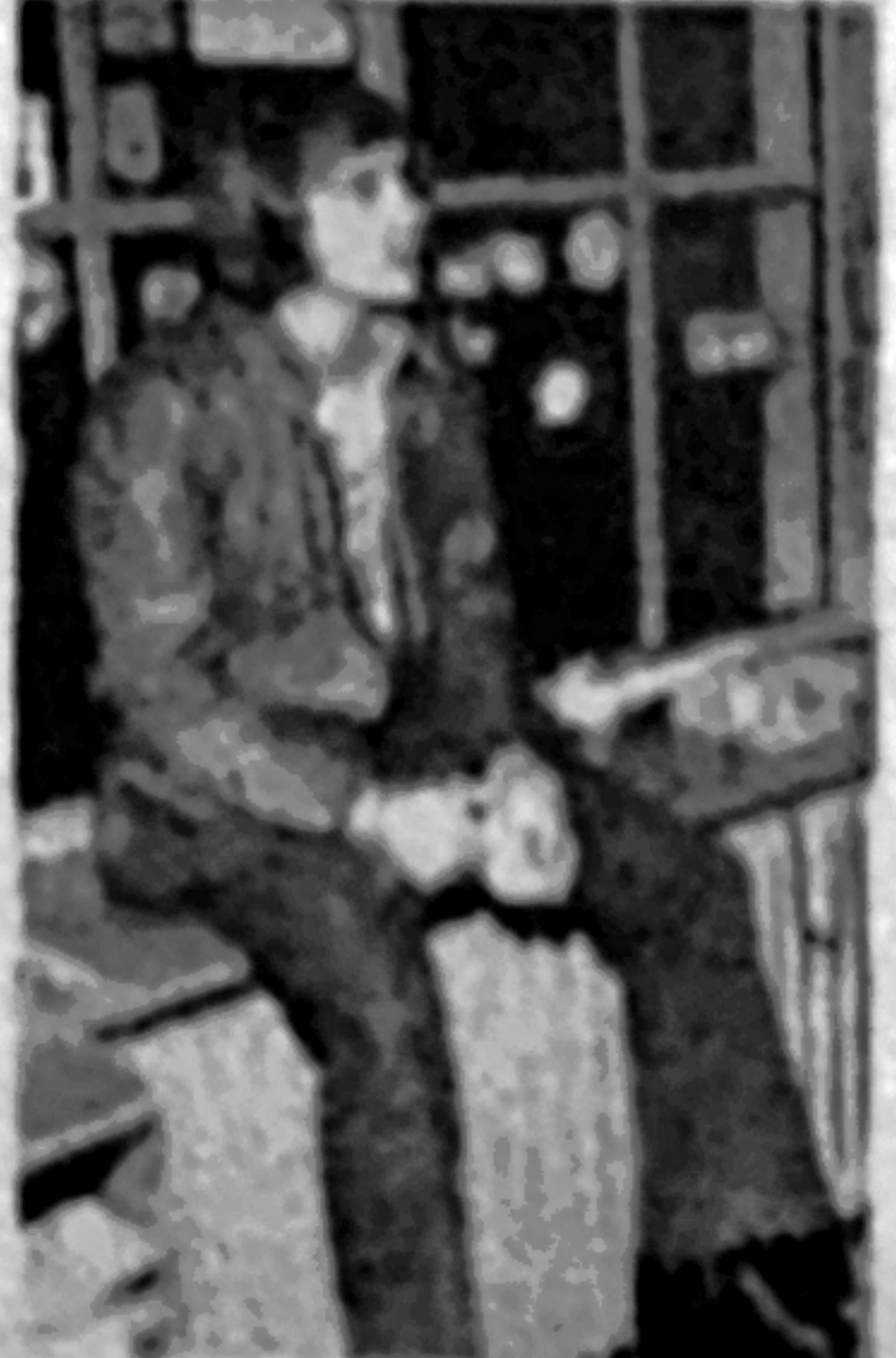
David and Mark Wesley have the same sense of humour! Here they are during the live broadcast.
