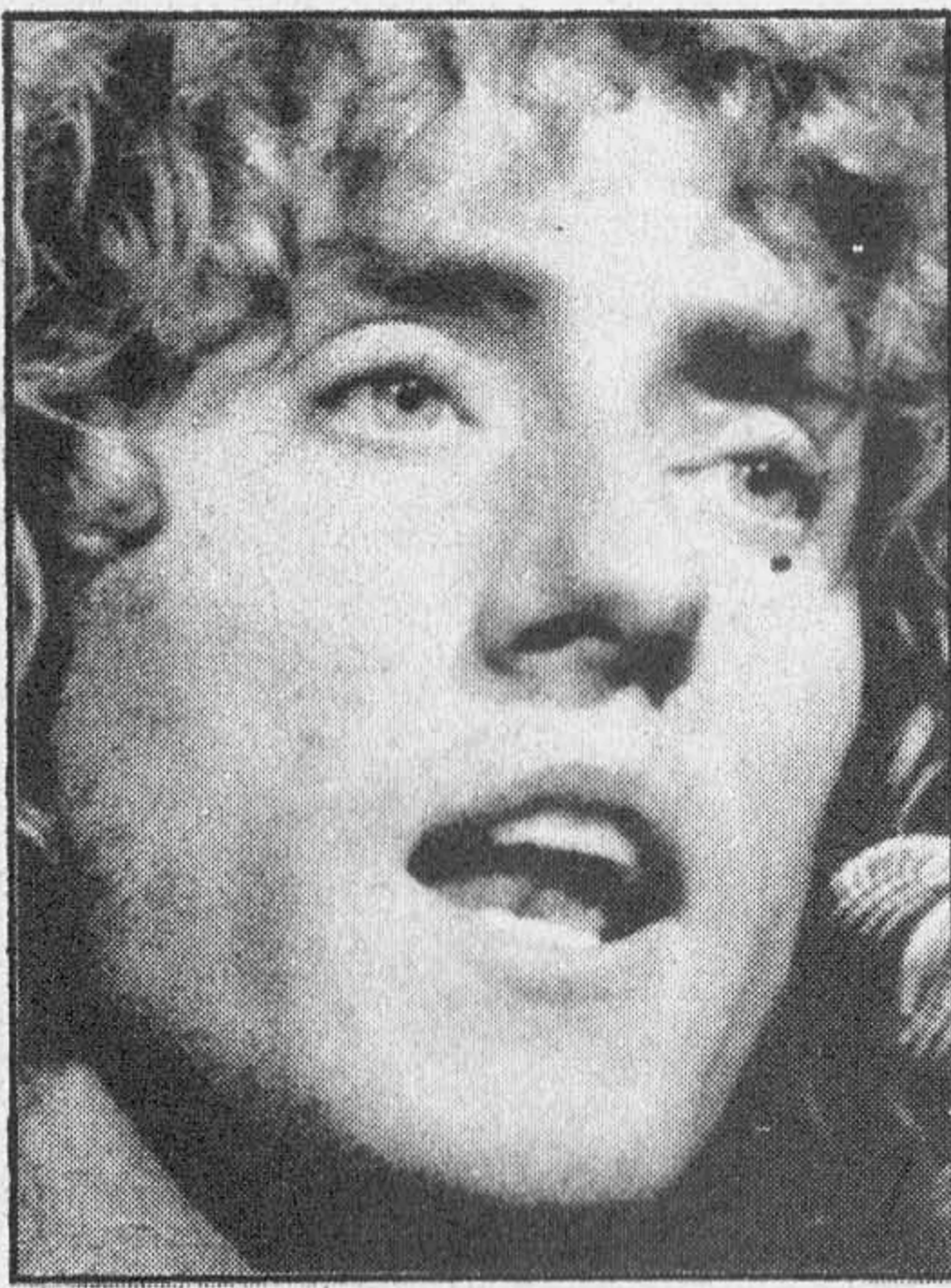
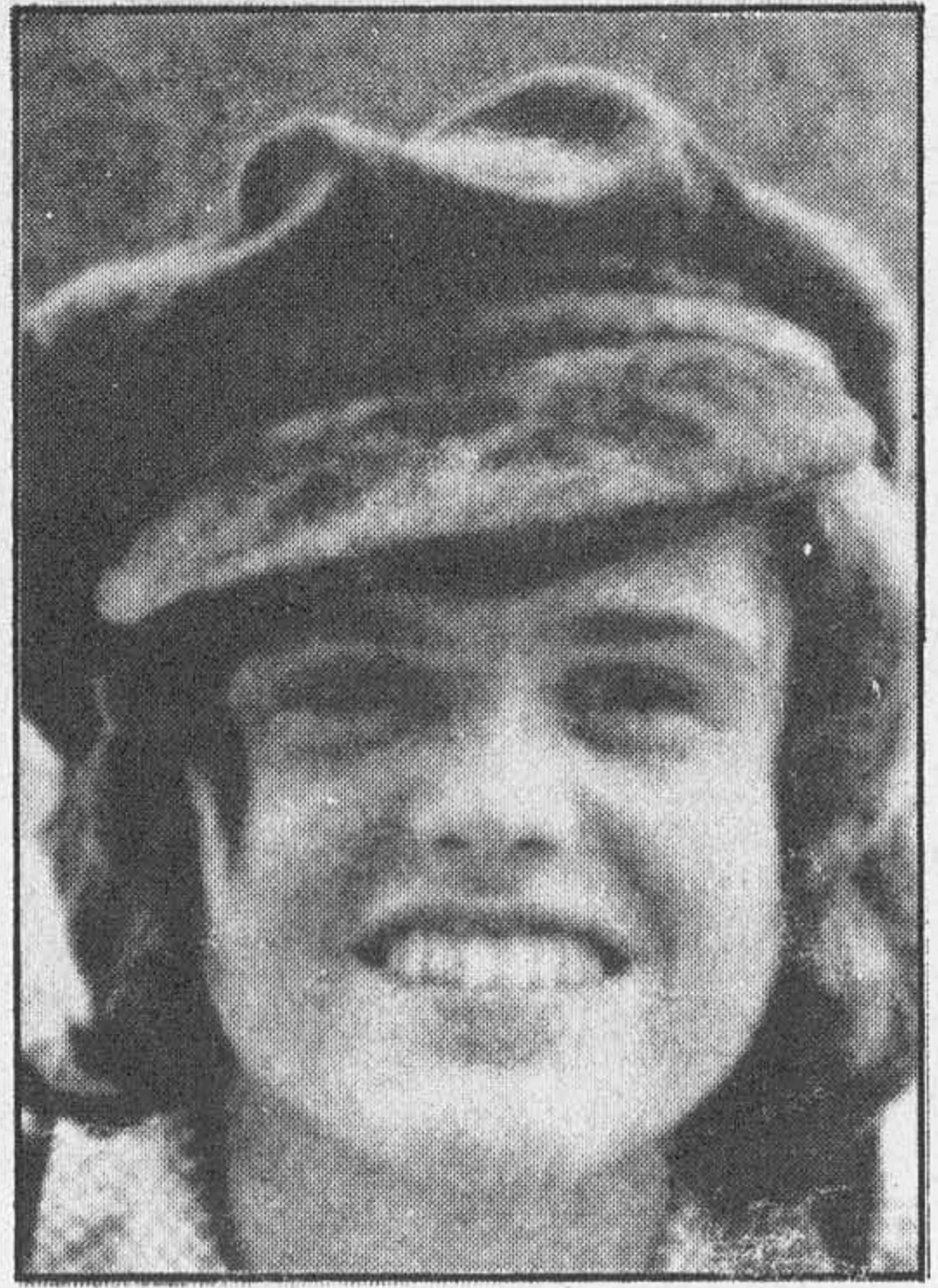

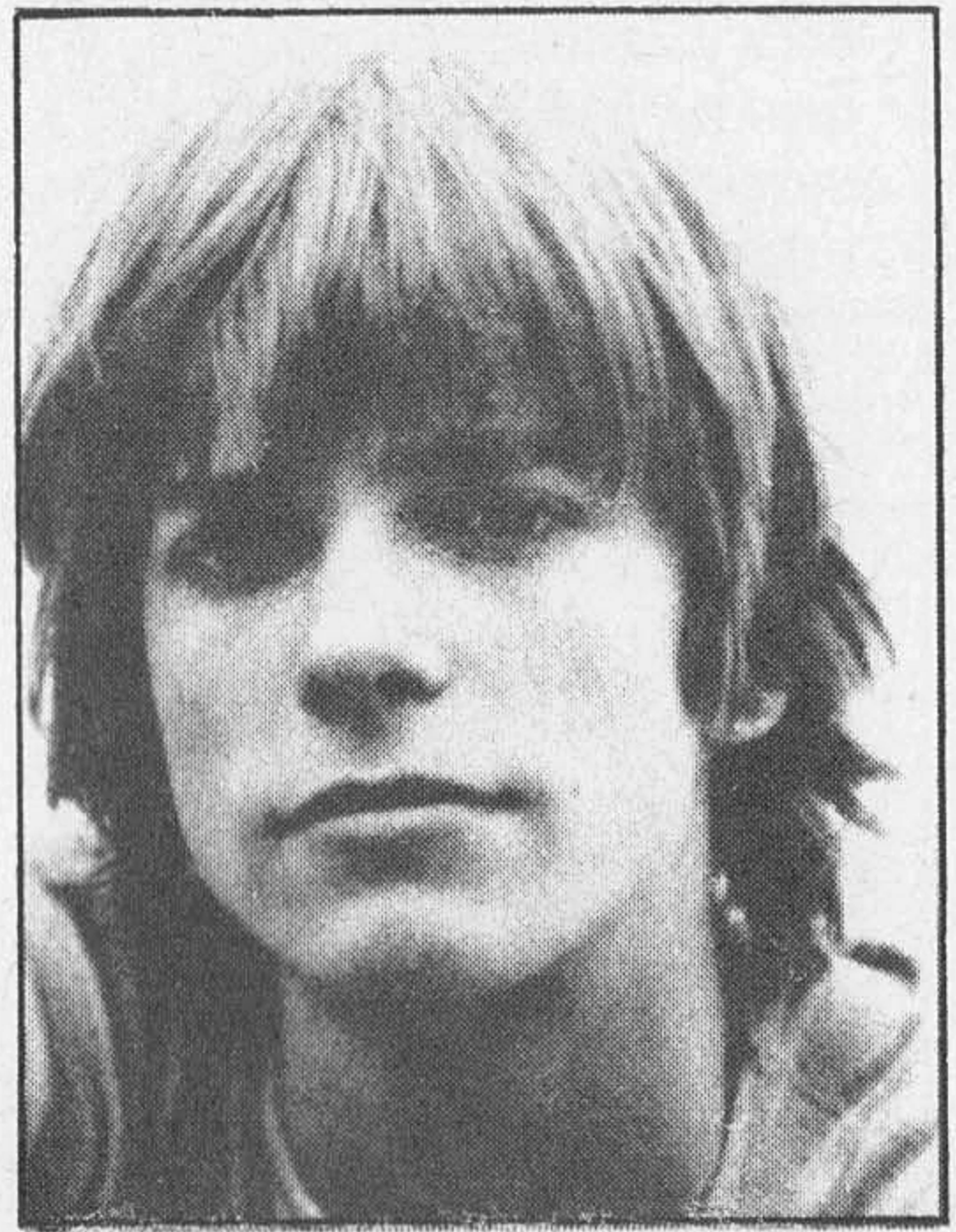


Tommy — Again . . .
