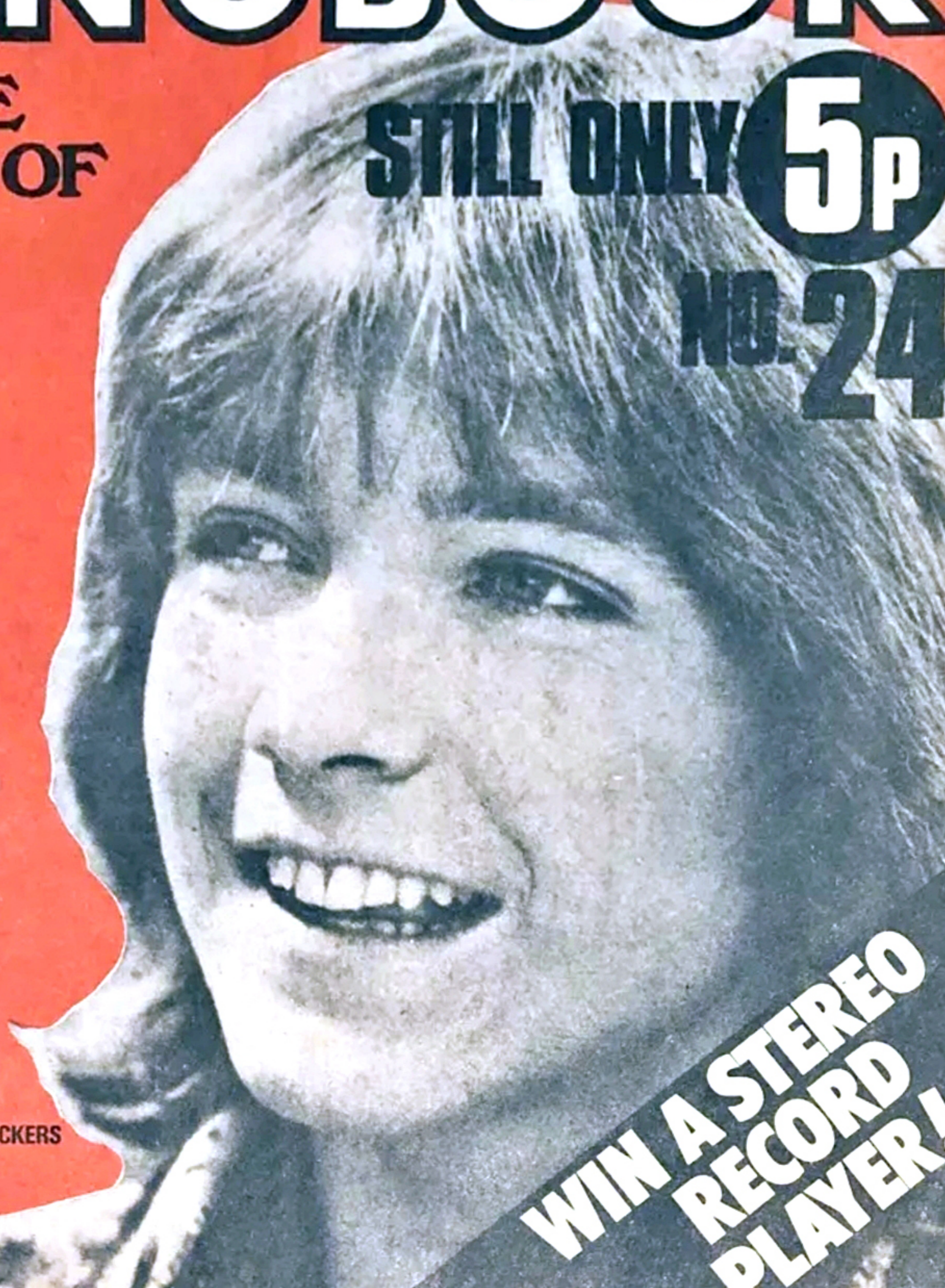

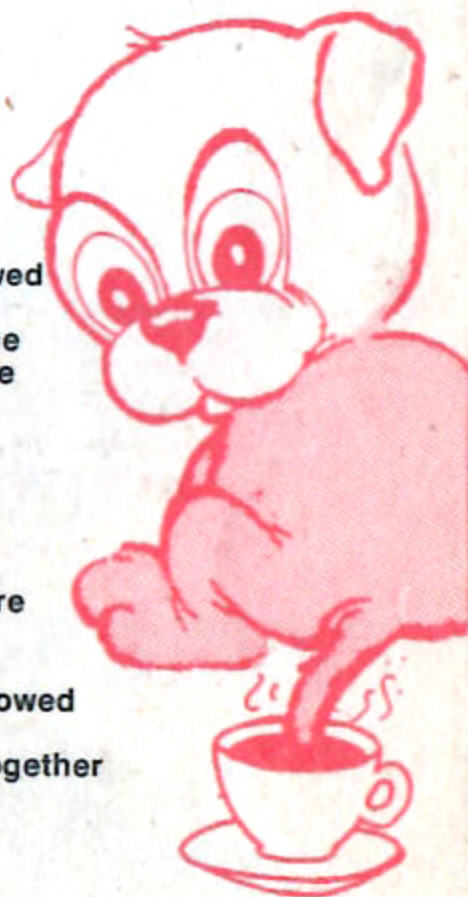
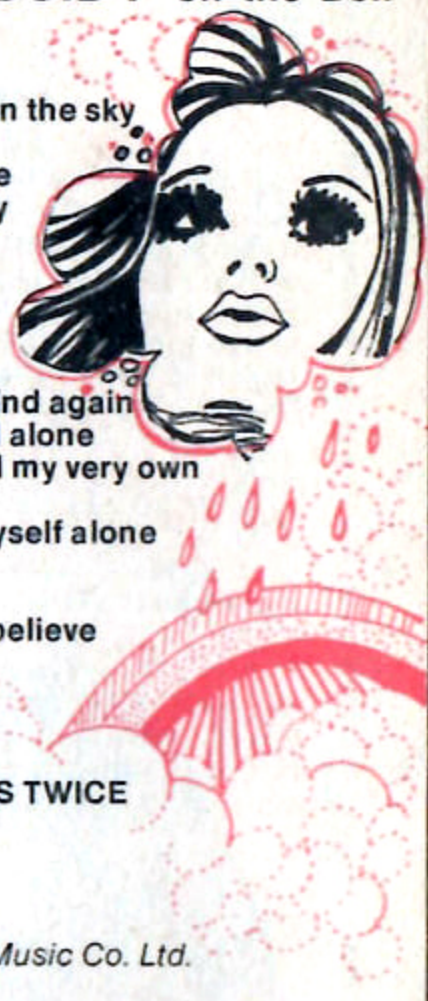

- HOPES TO START BREEDING SOON!

It's a hard life being a Superstar, as David Cassidy knows only too well. The past months have certainly demanded a great deal of David's attention—rising very early every morning and working solidly on the *Partridge Family* series until late evening and then having to rush off to the recording studios to complete *Partridge Family* recordings and sort out his own solo career as well! It's enough to drive a person mad!

But David, being a very sane person, seems pretty much in control of the whole situation. In December he leaves the *Partridge Family* series for good and plans to devote most of his time to his recording career and basically enjoying himself as much as possible.

HOUSE IN HAWAII

First on the agenda is the house that David plans to build for himself in Hawaii. He's bought a huge plot of land that cost quite a considerable amount of money and he hopes to take a couple of months off to get the house sorted out. From what we've heard he's got some really great ideas for the construction of the place and also plans to have his horses

sent out there so that he can start breeding them, which is something he's wanted to do for a long, long time. Just imagine, there may be a Cassidy Ranch in Hawaii before long!

NEW ALBUM!

As far as his recording career goes, David is really in command. He's just completed a new solo album entitled *Dreams Are Nothing More Than Wishes* and he's really pleased with the results.

"I decided to record only the songs that I really like," he said. "Whereas before I was more or less told what to do, this time I had a big say in the matter and I included some songs that really mean a lot to me personally. There are also two songs that I wrote myself on the album and I think that they're the best I've ever written, so you can imagine why I'm pretty chuffed with the whole thing."

The album will be in the shops very soon and I know that there are lots of people who are really looking forward to hearing it—including us! Meanwhile, let's make David really happy by making his latest single the big hit that it deserves to be!
