

David's comeback after 10 years

Who would have thought it? David Cassidy, a singer who was celebrated worldwide over ten years ago, made a surprising comeback. His single "The Last Kiss" shot straight into the charts, followed closely by his LP "Romance."

Horse lover David Cassidy

David has been a horse lover since childhood. With his earnings as a singer and actor, he gradually built up a successful racehorse breeding business. Today, he keeps 50 horses on his ranch in California, which are constantly competing in races and events all over the world.

David's Brothers

Although David Cassidy's stepbrothers Shaun (above) and Patrick (8) also tried their hand at show business, they were never able to match the success of their famous brother. At least Shaun made it to the Golden BRAVO Otto winner as a singer in 1976 and 1977. Patrick, on the other hand, tried his hand as lead singer and drummer in the group Quorum, but never achieved more than a modicum of success.

At the age of 24, he suddenly called it quits.

Hits such as "I'm a Clown," "Cherish," and "Rock Me Baby" sold millions of copies around the world. In 1973, he played six times at London's Empire Pool Wembley in front of a total of 70,000 spectators, becoming the first foreign musician to come close to the Beatles' records. But after a concert in New York, David ended his music career overnight at the age of 24.
