Harrah's salute to a decade

the Fiesta Showroom, three names will be drawn to determine contestants to play the "Prize is Right". Once selected, contestants must guess the 1970s cost of a variety of everyday items. Contestants will accumulate points for every correctly priced item, which in turn wins them punches on a giant prize board.

Entries into the drawings may be earned in several ways, such as checking into the hotel, dining at Harrah's restaurants, playing slots, keno or table games, betting in the race and sports book as well as signing up for a Total Gold Card (free membership; details available at the Total Rewards Center on the main casino floor).

DAVID CASSIDY

On May 23 and 24, the '70s party gets a special treat when former teen idol and pop icon David Cassidy, returns to Harrah's Laughlin for two concerts.

Cassidy was the poster boy of the '70s. By age 21, he was the world's highest paid solo live performer and his fan club was the most popular in the world, exceeding those of both the Beatles and Elvis Presley. Starring as Keith Partridge in the popular TV sit-com "The Partridge Family," Cassidy played the role of a musician, while trying to launch a separate career as a rock star in his own right.

His musical success garnered multiple Grammy nominations and 18 of his recordings reached gold or platinum status, with four consecutive multi-platinum releases.

While at Harrah's Laughlin, Cassidy will perform one show per night at 8 p.m. in the Rio Vista Outdoor Amphitheater. Tickets are appropriately priced at \$19.70 and are available at Harrah's Box Office or by calling 702-298-8510.

DISCO DUCKING

The '70s party will culminate with a disco party set for Harrah's convention area on May 26. The night of disco will feature a live band, dancing, a '70s costume contest, drink special and authentic '70s decor (this is where the lava lamps come in; plus

strobe lights and silent '70s videos). The party will take place from 9 p.m. until 1 a.m. with free admission.

"BEWITCHED" BEGINS

Before the '70s leave the building, Harrah's will introduce a new show that is very 2001. On Friday, May 25, Greg Thompson Productions begins a run in the Fiesta Showroom of their magical show, "Bewitched."
