## Ideal Casting For David

David Cassidy is a young actor who claims his musical ability comes from his father naturally, and from his step-mother by osmosis.

David co-stars as 16-year-old Keith Partridge in The Partridge Family, new comedywith-music series on ABC, Fridays at 8:30 PM. David's mother in the series is songstress Shirley Jones—David's step-mother in real life.

"I've been singing most of my life," Cassidy reveals, "and I'm sure I inherited my musical ability from my father, Jack Cassidy (former co-star of the He and She series), whom I'm sure you know acts as well as sings."



In The Partridge Family, David plays the oldest of five children who join their widowed mother in forming a singing group that hits it big in show business.

"It's really a fun experience," the good-

looking youngster states. "I once thought about forming a group of my own. I've played the clarinet since I was eight years old, and now play the drums and the guitar."

In the series, David is the leader of the family group.

"We sing a different song in every episode and I really think they're of Top 40 calibre. Someone said we have a sound something like the Fifth Dimension, and you can't do better than that."

David, who made his Broadway debut in "Fig Leaves Are Falling" and has gueststarred in a number of top TV shows, feels his first series is almost too good to be true.

"It's ideal—the perfect thing for me. I'm really fortunate, because very few singeractors get to do both in a series. Also, it's the first real comedy I've done on TV—my guest appearances have all been dramatic," he states. He doesn't mention that his dramatic appearances on such series as Marcus Welby, M.D., Medical Center and The Mod Squad have won considerable critical acclaim.

David's singing voice is a trained one—he has a legitimate baritone, but he can sing blues as well.

"Actually, I like to sing sophisticated rock, and that's essentially what we sing in the series."

Since he wants to be known primarily as an actor, however, The Partridge Family seems the best of both worlds.
