

David Cassidy at Rose Festival

Entertainment plans for the 1972 Portland Rose Festival are now complete, with events slanted to a variety of ages and tastes. Festival dates are June 2-11.

David Cassidy, star of the TV Partridge Family Show and idol of the sub-teen set, will head up a show Sunday, June 4, at 2:30 p.m. in the Coliseum.

For the all-family audience, singer Ed Ames will appear Saturday night, June 10. The under-30 crowd will have its event Monday night, June 12, with the Sounds of Young

show featuring Jethro Tull. For this event, festival-type seating will prevail, which means "sit where you want."

This year the queen selection and coronation will be the festival's first official event, Friday, June 2, at 8 p.m. in the Coliseum. Also booked in the Coliseum is the Grand Floral Parade, Saturday, June 10.

General admission tickets will be sold to the Portland Rose Show at the Masonic Temple June 8 and 9, the Drag Races at West Delta Park June 3 and 4 and the

Rose Cup Sports Car Races June 10 and 11, also at West Delta Park.
