Adding the wreath of successful major-city concert tour to laurels already won on the Broadway stage, TV sound stage, and record sales charts provides the current ambition for David Cassidy. The youthful star of ABC's "The Partridge Family" series will make his first local appearance at 3 p.m. on Saturday, February 27th at the Baltimore Civic Center.

Before reaching his 21st birthday, David had achieved success with the Los Angeles Theatre Group, a co-starring role on Broadway in Allan Sherman's "The Fig Leaves Are Falling;" and had played dramatic roles in TV's "Ironsides," "The Survivors," "Marcus Welby," "Adam 12," "Mod Squad," and "Bonanza."

The combo has two albums over the million mark, a single, "I Think I Love You" over 5 million, and another entitled "Doesn't Somebody Want To Be Wanted" going past 1½ million copies in a month after release.
