

# *Nation's First Lady Tops List of 'Best Coiffured'*

ATLANTIC CITY, N.J. (AP) — Pat Nixon, the nation's first lady, was chosen the "best coiffured woman in the nation" at the convention here Sunday of the New Jersey Master Hairdressers and Cosmetologists Association.

Mrs. Nixon topped the list of 10 women and 10 men chosen by the Association's executive committee as the "best coiffured" among public figures. It was the first year men were chosen, in response to the increasing male patronage of hairdressers.

Other women on the list were actresses Jane Fonda, Elizabeth Taylor, Faye Dunaway, and Alexis Smith, singers Diahann

Carrol and Dinah Shore; models Twiggy and Marissa Berenson, and U.S. Sen. Margaret Chase Smith, R-Maine.

The men on the list were television figures David Cassidy, Dick Cavett and Burt Reynolds; actor Ryan O'Neal, newsman Dan Rather, Golfer Arnold Palmer, U.S. Sen. Charles Percy, R-Ill., bandleader Doc Seaverinsen, New Jersey State Sen. Joseph McGahn, D-Atlantic, and New York Mayor John V. Lindsay.
